Purpose of Disaster **Prevention Tour Guide**

The purpose of Disaster Prevention Tour Guide is to enhance participants' awareness of disaster risk management by taking the participants to the seawall and by telling them the situation then and now of Taro district, which suffered tremendous damage from the Great East Japan Earthquake, as a lesson for succeeding generations. Furthermore, the participants will watch a video of tsunami previously unreleased to the mass media. (Reservation is required.)

Indication of tsunami water levels




- Tsunami water level (17.3m) of Great East Japan Earthquake in 2011
